



City of Shoreline Off-Leash Area (OLA) Rules Shoreview Park Pilot Site

- 1. Prior to entry, dogs must be healthy and owners/handlers must comply with King County Animal Control regulations, including having their dog(s) fully immunized, dewormed and licensed prior to entering the OLA.**
- 2. Entry to the OLA is at the risk of dog owners, handlers or visitors. Owner/handlers are legally responsible for any damage or injury caused by their dogs.**
- 3. Children under age fourteen (14) must be accompanied by an adult.**
- 4. All food, including dog treats, is prohibited.**
- 5. Dog(s) must be under voice control of their owner/handler at all times in OLA.**
- 6. Owners/Handlers must have their dog(s) on-leash at all times unless in the designated OLA.**
- 7. Owners/handlers may have no more than three (3) dogs per person at OLA.**
- 8. Owners/handlers must remove pinch, spike or choke collars from their dogs before entering the OLA.**
- 9. Owners/handlers must possess their dog(s) collar with identification, current dog license and current rabies tags at all times in the OLA>**
- 10. Owners/handlers must carry a leash for each dog while in the OLA.**
- 11. Owners/handlers must remain with and watch their dog(s) in the OLA at all times.**
- 12. Owners/handlers must promptly clean up after their dogs by enclosing feces in plastic bag and disposing of it in designated trash receptacles.**
- 13. Owners/handlers and their dog(s) that exhibit or have a history of aggressive/dangerous behavior are prohibited.**
- 14. Owners/handlers must leash aggressive dogs immediately and remove them from the premises.**
- 15. Owners/handlers with puppies under four months and female dogs in heat are prohibited from entering the site.**
- 16. Bicycles, skateboards, rollerskates, rollerblades and strollers are prohibited.**
