# Stay Informed About City News

**Alert Shoreline** – Get alerted about emergencies and other important community news by signing up for Alert Shoreline. This system provides you with critical information such as police alerts for your neighborhood. It will also allow us to alert you to community news you are interested in receiving, such as agendas, facility closures, and news. Sign up at [shorelinewa.gov/alert](http://shorelinewa.gov/alert).

**Currents** – Published 10 times a year, Shoreline’s newsletter provides information about current and upcoming City projects, issues and events. It is mailed to every Shoreline address and can be read online on the City’s website at [shorelinewa.gov/currents](http://shorelinewa.gov/currents)

**City website** – Shoreline’s website at [shorelinewa.gov](http://shorelinewa.gov) provides extensive up-to-date information on City projects, budgets, issues and public meetings.

**Council Meetings Online** – Watch Council meetings live on the web at [shorelinewa.gov/councilmeetings](http://shorelinewa.gov/councilmeetings). Video archives are also available to review.

**Council Meeting Agendas and Staff Reports** – Agendas and staff reports, along with the ordinances and resolutions being considered, are posted on the City’s website the week prior to the Council meeting.

**Council Agenda Planner** – A calendar for future Council agenda items can be found on the Council webpage. Please note this schedule is subject to frequent change.

**Government Access Cable** – Those who have cable service within Shoreline city limits may watch the City’s government access cable channel on Verizon 37 and Comcast 21. Meetings are broadcast at noon and 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday and at 6:00 a.m., noon and 8:00 p.m. Wednesday through Sunday for the week following the meeting.
